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1 **I. STATEMENT OF CLAIM**

2 Plaintiff's Claim arises from the State of California's unwillingness to count
3 and report Write-In Votes for the 2020 U.S. Presidential Ticket of Ryan
4 Ehrenreich (for President) and Veronica Ehrenreich (for Vice President). As
5 justification for not counting or reporting said Write-In Votes, functionaries
6 of the Defendant have cited various state-level statutes (i.e. CA Elec Code
7 § 8650-8653) that require Plaintiff to produce fifty-five (55) sworn Electors
8 for the purpose of Electoral College Voting by the deadline of October 20,
9 2020 as a precondition for the State of California counting or reporting
10 Write-In Votes for Plaintiff's Candidacy.

11 However, in communications with Defendant's functionaries on this matter,
12 Plaintiff has already stipulated that he is aware of said requirement, but has
13 asserted repeatedly that said requirement is unconstitutional (see Exhibits
14 C, E, and G). Instead, he has requested, as a compromise, that
15 Defendant's functionaries allow for the counting and reporting of Write-In
16 Votes for Plaintiff's Candidacy without requiring Plaintiff to produce said list
17 of fifty-five sworn Electors. Yet Defendant's functionaries have repeatedly
18 refused or ignored Plaintiff's attempt at compromise (see Exhibit F).

19 In filing this Complaint, Plaintiff brings to the Court his assertion that, upon
20 the State of California providing the means to cast a Write-In Vote for any

1 particular Contest for Office and upon a Voter exercising said means to
2 cast a Write-In Vote, any subsequent exclusion of said already cast Write-
3 In Vote by the State of California from the counting and/or reporting
4 processes is unconstitutional. Moreover, Plaintiff asserts that said situation
5 is unconstitutional, regardless of statutory or other rationale provided by the
6 State of California, including but not limited to CA Elec Code § 8600-8606
7 (2018), CA Elec Code § 8650-8653 (2018), or other statute(s).
8 Furthermore, Plaintiff asserts that this standard applies to all other U.S.
9 States or Districts that provide the means to cast Write-In Votes.

10 Plaintiff now offers to the Court relevant background information about the
11 specifics of Plaintiff's Claim, including:

12 1) The Plaintiff, Ryan Stephen Ehrenreich, is properly registered and in
13 good standing with the Federal Election Commission (FEC) as a
14 Presidential Write-In Candidate for the 2020 U.S. General Election.
15 As proof of Mr. Ehrenreich's registration with the FEC, a screenshot
16 of Mr. Ehrenreich's FEC Candidacy page
17 ([https://www.fec.gov/data/candidate/P00011395/?tab=about-](https://www.fec.gov/data/candidate/P00011395/?tab=about-candidate)
18 [candidate](https://www.fec.gov/data/candidate/P00011395/?tab=about-candidate)) is included as Exhibit A. Also, Mr. Ehrenreich's FEC
19 Form 2 is included as Exhibit B.

1 2) Mr. Ehrenreich has campaigned in person in the State of California
2 on multiple occasions throughout the course of the 2020 U.S.
3 Presidential Election (see Exhibits O, P, and U), using a large sign
4 to direct interested voters to visit his Campaign Website URL (i.e.
5 “www.Ryan4Prez.com”), which for the duration of his campaign has
6 automatically re-directed visitors to the Official Facebook Page for
7 his Candidacy (i.e. “https://www.facebook.com/Ryan4Prez”). On this
8 Facebook Page, he has shared links to posts from his Official
9 Twitter Account (i.e. “https://twitter.com/rehrenreich”).

10 3) Mr. Ehrenreich has explained often in the course of his 2020 U.S.
11 Presidential Campaign that Aid to Families with Dependent Children
12 (AFDC) created the Middle Class by implicitly creating a Price
13 Support for Labor. Additionally, he has offered many unique,
14 innovative, well-reasoned solutions to the most pressing problems
15 facing our country, often using Price Supports as the underlying
16 structure for these solutions (for examples, generally see Exhibits N
17 through AW).

18 4) On October 7th, 2020, Mr. Ehrenreich sent a letter signed by both
19 himself and his running mate, Veronica Ehrenreich, to Defendant’s
20 functionaries for election-related matters via USPS Certified Mail

1 informing said functionaries that his U.S. Presidential Write-In Ticket
2 refuses to fulfill the State of California's filing requirements for Write-
3 In Candidates, asserting that said filing requirements are
4 unconstitutional, and proposing that the State of California agree to
5 count and report votes for his U.S. Presidential Write-In Ticket
6 regardless of his Ticket not meeting said filing requirements (see
7 Exhibits C and D).

8 5) On October 8th, 2020, Mr. Ehrenreich also faxed this letter to
9 Defendant's functionaries for election matters (see Exhibit E).

10 6) On October 9th, 2020, Defendant's functionaries for election
11 matters mailed a reply re-iterating the standard filing requirements
12 that the State of California imposes on Write-In Candidates (see
13 Exhibit F).

14 7) On October 23rd, 2020, Mr. Ehrenreich again faxed a letter to
15 Defendant's functionaries for election matters proposing that they
16 provide his U.S. Presidential Write-In Ticket with an exception to the
17 State of California's filing requirements for Presidential Write-In
18 Tickets (see Exhibit G).

19 8) On October 25th, 2020, Mr. Ehrenreich cast a Write-In Vote for
20 himself on the Official Ballot that was mailed to him at this residence

1 and deposited said Ballot in the Official Sacramento County Ballot
2 Drop-Box at Citrus Heights City Hall.

3 9) On October 27th, 2020, Mr. Ehrenreich's Ballot was accepted by the
4 relevant election officials, as recorded by BallotTrax (see Exhibit K).

5 10) On November 2nd & 3rd, 2020, Mr. Ehrenreich tweeted to various
6 news organizations in the State of California, various college
7 football programs in the State of California, and more generally to
8 California Voters, asking for Write-In Votes in the State of California
9 (see Exhibits AX, AY, and AZ).

10 11) On November 5th, 2020, Mr. Ehrenreich again faxed a letter to
11 Defendant's functionaries for election matters requesting that they
12 count and report votes for his U.S. Presidential Write-In Ticket (see
13 Exhibit M).

14 12) As of the filing of this Complaint, Write-In Vote totals for Mr.
15 Ehrenreich Candidacy have not been reported (see Exhibit N).

16 To provide further context for the Controversy of this Complaint, Plaintiff
17 now registers relevant observations about the State of California's
18 enforcement of CA Elec Code § 8650-8653 and other similar statutes:

1 1) Even though the State of California commits to ballot secrecy in the
2 Constitution of the State of California (see California Constitution
3 Article 2 § 7) and various state-level election statutes, the State of
4 California still requires fifty-five (55) Voters to publicly reveal their
5 support for a particular Presidential Write-In Ticket prior to counting
6 and reporting votes for said Presidential Write-In Ticket.

7 2) On many Official State Ballots, including those Ballots printed for
8 Sacramento County (i.e. the county where Plaintiff voted), the State
9 of California fails to inform Voters of the requirements of CA Elec
10 Code § 8650-8653 and other similar statutes. Also, the State of
11 California fails to explicitly warn Voters that their Write-In Votes may
12 not be counted or reported. Instead, the State of California offers only
13 an extremely ambiguous reference in the Ballot Instructions as to how
14 to vote for a “qualified write-in candidate”, making no reference to
15 what conditions determine who is a “qualified write-in candidate”, how
16 to obtain a list of such candidates, or what happens to a Write-In Vote
17 cast for a candidate that the State does NOT deem to be a “qualified
18 write-in candidate” (see Exhibits H, I, and J).

19 3) On many Official State Ballots, including those Ballots printed for
20 Sacramento County (i.e. the county where Plaintiff voted), the State

1 of California provides a Write-In Option (e.g. a bubble with a blank
2 field for writing in a candidate) for many Contests for Office without
3 informing the Voter of any conditions that may affect whether a Write-
4 In Vote cast using such means is actually counted and reported.

5 4) On many instructions for Official State Vote-by-Mail Ballots, including
6 those instructions provided in Sacramento County (i.e. the county
7 where Plaintiff voted), the State of California also fails to inform
8 Voters of the requirements of CA Elec Code § 8650-8653 and other
9 similar statutes (see Exhibits H, I, and J).

10 5) The text of CA Elec Code § 8650-8653 and related statutes place no
11 burden on the State of California to notify Voters that said statutes
12 exist or of their implications on whether a Write-In Vote cast by a
13 validly registered Voter is subsequently excluded from the counting
14 and reporting processes.

15 6) The text of CA Elec Code § 8650-8653 and related statutes place no
16 burden on the State of California to provide a standard means for
17 Voters who are aware of said statutes' existence to learn which
18 particular Write-In Candidates meet the State's threshold for a
19 "qualified write-in candidate".

1 7) Even if CA Elec Code § 8650-8653 and related statutes did place a
2 burden on the State of California to inform Voters on these matters,
3 Voters would still need to read, understand, and interpret information
4 from Off-Ballot Resources to definitively know which Write-In
5 Candidates meet the State's threshold for a "qualified write-in
6 candidate".

7 8) In order to consult such Off-Ballot Resources, Voters would need to
8 maintain their own access to these Off-Ballot Resources (e.g. internet
9 access, cellular data, ability to drive to a State Office to obtain a
10 hardcopy of a printed list, etc.) at their own cost.

11 Noting these points, as CA Elec Code § 8650-8653 and related statutes are
12 currently drafted, these statutes shift the burden onto Voters to educate
13 themselves on State statutory law; to read, understand, and interpret
14 information in determining whether any specific Write-In Candidate meets
15 the State's threshold of a "qualified write-in candidate"; and to maintain
16 their own access to such information at their own cost.

17 Additionally, in requiring Candidates to provide fifty-five sworn Elector
18 signatures, each with notarization, the State of California imposes a
19 tremendous cost on Write-In Candidates. Taken in total, these costs

1 represent a tremendous implicit Filing Fee imposed by the State of
2 California upon Write-In Candidates, many of whom are subject to limited
3 financial means.

4 Furthermore, in requiring a subset of Voters to publicly reveal their support
5 for a particular Write-In Candidate before the State of California will agree
6 to count and report Write-In Votes for said Candidate, the State of
7 California is requiring said Voters to subject themselves to the potential
8 political, economic, or social repercussions that may be inflicted upon
9 public backers of fringe Candidates.

10 Plaintiff notes that this last point is especially pertinent to his Candidacy.
11 Plaintiff has tweeted information about the direct causal relationship
12 between the termination of AFDC and the overall weakening of the U.S.
13 Middle Class to many of the most powerful current U.S. Politicians and
14 mainstream News Outlets (for examples, generally see Exhibits N through
15 AW). This information directly implicates both major U.S. political parties
16 (i.e. the Republicans and Democrats) in causing many of the most pressing
17 economic problems facing a majority of Americans. To his knowledge,
18 neither this information, nor his Candidacy, has ever been publicly
19 acknowledged by any of these recipients. This situation clearly indicates

1 that Plaintiff is a fringe candidate and that publicly backing him presents
2 personal risk to his backers.

3 This is exactly the type of scenario that ballot secrecy requirements intend
4 to protect against. Ballot secrecy requirements are in place to prevent
5 Voters from incurring such personal risk in this type of scenario by allowing
6 said Voters to privately support Candidates of their own choosing. Plaintiff's
7 backers should not be required to personally risk running afoul of the two-
8 party power structure that controls our electoral system in order to cast a
9 Write-In Vote for Plaintiff that is actually counted and reported. In requiring
10 fifty-five backers to disclose their support publicly prior to the election, the
11 State of California shirks its obligation to protect the secrecy of the ballot
12 and instead acts as an agent of the two-party power structure. In forcing
13 those fifty-five backers to disclose their public support, the State of
14 California makes said backers into targets for political, economic, and/or
15 social repercussions, denying said backer equal protections under the law.
16 Based on these facts, Plaintiff asserts that CA Elec Code § 8650-8653, as
17 well as any related statutes that exclude already cast Write-In Votes from
18 the counting and/or reporting processes, are unconstitutional state-level
19 statutes, as they stand in violation of the First (1st), Fifth (5th), and

1 Fourteenth (14th) Amendments to the Constitution of the United States of
2 America (and possibly other Amendments, as well, depending on the
3 characteristics of Voters whose Write-In Votes were excluded from the
4 counting and/or reporting processes due to the enforcement of these
5 statutes). These statutes clearly abridge the Right to Vote in the manner
6 explained in this Complaint, thus also depriving Voters of their rights to
7 Free Speech, Due Process, and Equal Protection of the Law.

8 Additionally, Plaintiff asserts that ANY state-level statute that yields a Ballot
9 that is so structured as to require a Voter to consult Off-Ballot Resources
10 (including, but not limited to, pamphlets, supplemental materials, news
11 publications, websites, etc.) to determine the validity of ANY Choice that
12 can be entered on the Ballot is unconstitutional. Plaintiff asserts ANY such
13 statute also stands in violation of the First (1st), Fifth (5th), and Fourteenth
14 (14th) Amendments to the Constitution of the United States of America
15 (and possibly other Amendments, as described previously) by similarly
16 abridging the Right to Vote.

17 Furthermore, Plaintiff asserts that, upon a validly registered Voter using the
18 provided means to cast Write-In Vote(s) on Official State Ballots, ANY
19 state-level statute that excludes said already cast Write-In Vote(s) from

1 counting and/or report processes is unconstitutional. Plaintiff asserts ANY
2 such statute also stands in violation of the First (1st), Fifth (5th), and
3 Fourteenth (14th) Amendments to the Constitution of the United States of
4 America (and possibly other Amendments, as described previously) by
5 similarly abridging the Right to Vote.

6 Finally, Plaintiff asserts that, by enforcing CA Elec Code § 8650-8653 and
7 related statutes that exclude already cast Write-In Votes, the State of
8 California has inflicted grave, serious, and time-sensitive harm upon Mr.
9 Ehrenreich and his Candidacy for the Office of President of the United
10 States of America. This is so because, by refusing to count and report
11 Write-In Votes, the State of California has denied Mr. Ehrenreich's
12 Presidential Ticket the possibility of securing Electoral College Votes and
13 prevented his Ticket from using his showing in the official results to further
14 bolster his current and future national campaigns.

15 Plaintiff, who is NOT a lawyer, petitions the Court in the form of this Federal
16 Pro Se Complaint asking the Court to aid him in redressing this harm in an
17 urgent, expeditious manner. The Court's aid is especially important, given
18 the small timeframe between the November 3rd U.S. General Election and

1 the voting by Presidential Electors (aka the Electoral College vote) to
2 determine the next President of the United States of America.

3 In this regard, Plaintiff is also requesting that the Court issue an injunction
4 to prevent the State of California from certifying Presidential Election
5 Results or choosing a Slate of Presidential Electors until AFTER the Court
6 reaches a decision on this Case.

7 **II. IRREPARABLE INJURY**

8 The prospect of the Electoral College vote occurring prior to this Case
9 being decided clearly presents an Irreparable Injury to the Plaintiff. With
10 this in mind, Plaintiff is requesting an injunction to prevent the State of
11 California from certifying election results until after this Case has been
12 decided.

13 Plaintiff notes that Defendant may have a desire to so burden Plaintiff in the
14 handling of this Complaint as to entice Plaintiff into abandoning this
15 Complaint. This may be done by means including, but not limited to, filing
16 numerous legal motions that Plaintiff must answer, requesting costly-to-
17 produce documents as part of discovery, or other means generally
18 intended to place unbearable monetary and time commitments upon
19 Plaintiff.

1 Additionally, Plaintiff notes that the requested injunction is likely necessary
2 to bring the incentives for a speedy resolution of this Case into alignment
3 between Plaintiff and Defendant. Plaintiff also notes that the potential harm
4 caused by needing, but not having, this injunction drastically outweighs any
5 burden the injunction places on Defendant.

6 Plaintiff asserts that it is in the best interest of both parties, as well as the
7 Court itself, that the Court issues the requested injunction so as to bring the
8 incentives of both parties into alignment on this matter and to produce a
9 speedy resolution.

10 **III. RELIEF REQUESTED**

11 Plaintiff requests the Court to order:

12 1) That CA Elec Code § 8600-8606 and CA Elec Code § 8650-8653 are
13 unconstitutional state-level statutes.

14 2) That for any state or jurisdiction (including District of Columbia) of the
15 United States of America which allows Voters the option to Write-In their
16 own choice (i.e. to Vote in Write-In form or to Write-In Vote) for any specific
17 ballot item, that, upon any Voter exercising said option, any state-level or
18 jurisdiction-level laws or statutes that restrict the validity, counting, and/or

1 reporting of individual Write-In Votes in which a legally registered Voter
2 writes no more than the required number of values (e.g. names of
3 candidates) of that Voter's own choosing, or is legally assisted in doing so,
4 are found to violate the guarantees provided by the First (1st), Fifth (5th),
5 and Fourteenth (14th) Amendments to the Constitution of the United State
6 of America, and as such are unconstitutional;

7 3) The immediate invalidation of any laws or statutes found to be
8 unconstitutional under Point #1 or Point #2 (such states where the Court
9 hereby invalidates one or more laws or statutes shall henceforth be
10 referred to as "affected states", and similarly, such jurisdictions shall
11 henceforth be referred to as "affected jurisdictions");

12 4) In affected states and affected jurisdictions, the immediate counting and
13 reporting of any Write-In Votes previously ignored, invalidated, discarded,
14 or in any other way not counted by justification of laws or statutes
15 invalidated under Point #3;

16 5) That in affected states and affected jurisdictions, the results produced
17 from Point #4 MUST be included in the overall results for any contest held
18 as part of the Nov 3, 2020 United States General Election (or any

1 subsequent election) PRIOR to the relevant election authorities determining
2 the winner(s) of any such contest;

3 6) That the performance of Points #4 and #5 MUST be completed prior to
4 any affected state or affected jurisdiction certifying the results of any
5 contest (or election) AND prior to any affected state or affected jurisdiction
6 finalizing any slate of Presidential Electors for the purpose of Electoral
7 College voting;

8 7) That if an affected state fails to meet the requirements of Points #4
9 through #6 in a timely manner, the Court finds that the rights of Voters in
10 that affected state have been abridged in such a manner that the U.S.
11 Congress may use said abridgement as justification to activate and enforce
12 the punishments listed under Section 2 of the 14th Amendment to the
13 Constitution of the United State of America (and possibly activate other
14 Sections and Amendments, as well);

15 8) That, for an affected state, if it is later found that that the differences
16 between Vote tallies produced BEFORE the performance of Points #4 and
17 #5 and produced AFTER said performance reveal a pattern of occurrence
18 whereby the Court, or any other U.S. legal body, official(s), or officer(s)
19 empowered to issue such finding, construes that the laws or statutes that

1 previously restricted Write-In Voting were applied, whether willfully or not,
2 in such a manner to result in the disenfranchisement of one or more
3 Protected Groups (or Protected Classes), the Court finds that the rights of
4 Voters in that affected state have been abridged in such a manner that the
5 U.S. Congress may use said abridgement as justification to activate and
6 enforce the punishments listed under Section 2 of the 14th Amendment to
7 the Constitution of the United State of America (and possibly activate other
8 Sections and Amendments, as well);

9 9) The immediate review, in all affected states and affected jurisdictions, of
10 all ballot designs used to print individual ballots that were used in the
11 casting of Votes in the 2020 U.S. Presidential Election, and upon
12 completion of said review, the requirement to report, out of the total number
13 of ballots cast by Voters in each affected state and affected jurisdiction, the
14 number of ballots cast that suffer from any defect found to be
15 unconstitutional due to the Court's decision in this Case, or arising from
16 laws or statutes found to be unconstitutional by the Court under Point #1 or
17 Point #2, as well as recommendations on how to rectify said ballot designs
18 in the future;

1 10) The determination and reporting of the total number of ballots cast
2 nation-wide that suffer from: a) any defect reported under Point #9 and/or
3 b) any rule, requirement, or imposition, or any possible assumption of
4 imposition, whether actually known to or assumed by the Voter at the time
5 of Voting or not, caused either directly or indirectly by an affected state or
6 affected jurisdiction holding as valid for enforcement any laws or statutes
7 subsequently found to be unconstitutional under Point #1 or Point #2;

8 11) That if the total number of ballots cast suffering from implication under
9 Point #10 is a number that meets or exceeds 50% of the total number of
10 ballots cast nation-wide in the 2020 U.S. Presidential Election, and if after
11 performance of Points #4 and #5, the ticket of Ryan Ehrenreich for
12 President and Veronica Ehrenreich for Vice President is not found to be the
13 winner of the 2020 U.S. Presidential Election, the Court shall order that the
14 results of the 2020 U.S. Presidential Election held on November 3rd, 2020
15 are invalid, null, and void and that a new Election shall be held to determine
16 the next President and Vice President of the United States of America at
17 the earliest possible date.



Only those names written on the ballot at the General Election for President of the United States, for which a group of 55 Presidential Electors pledge their votes to that write-in candidate, shall be counted as votes. § 8653¹

I. QUALIFICATIONS

A candidate for Presidential Elector must have a valid voter registration affidavit on file in the county of residence at the time nomination papers are obtained. There are no political party preference restrictions on electors; they need only be registered voters in California.

§ 201

In addition to qualifying the 55 Presidential Electors, the candidate for President of the United States must be a natural-born citizen of the United States, at least 35 years of age, and a resident of the United States for at least 14 years. U.S. Const., art. II, § 1, cl. 5

II. REQUIREMENTS

DECLARATION OF WRITE-IN CANDIDACY--PRESIDENTIAL ELECTOR

1. Voters in the Presidential General Election are technically voting for the 55 Presidential Elector candidates, not directly for the candidates for President and Vice President. Therefore, in order to be a write-in presidential candidate, that candidate must have 55 write-in Presidential Elector candidates file papers pledging themselves to the presidential candidate.
2. The 55 write-in candidates for Presidential Elector who have pledged themselves to vote for a candidate for President and a candidate for Vice President must file a Declaration of Write-In Candidacy, which must be received by the Secretary of State on or before October 20, 2020 (E-14). §§ 8650-8653

¹ All code section references are to the California Elections Code unless otherwise stated.

There are two variations of the declaration form:

- a. Declaration of Write-In Candidacy — Presidential Elector - Multiple Signature Form. This form includes spaces for more than one Presidential Elector write-in candidate to sign.
- b. Declaration of Write-In Candidacy — Presidential Elector - Single Signature Form. This form allows each of the 55 Presidential Elector write-in candidates to sign and submit separate forms.
- c. The Secretary of State and county elections officials do not supply Declarations of Write-In Candidacy — Presidential Elector; however, attached are suggested formats for each.

In addition to the elector candidate's name, these forms must also include the elector candidate's residence address, the date of the Presidential General Election, a statement stating that he or she is a write-in candidate for the office of Presidential Elector, an oath of office which must be signed in front of an officer authorized to administer oaths, such as a county elections official or a notary public, and the names of the presidential and vice presidential candidates to whom the elector candidate is pledged. § 8651

The Declaration of Write-In Candidacy can be mailed to or filed in person in the Elections Division of the Secretary of State's Office at 1500 11th Street, 5th Floor, Sacramento, California, 95814, or at any county elections office.

Please indicate on the envelope "Declaration of Write-In Candidacy." The Declaration of Write-In Candidacy must be received no later than October 20, 2020 (E-14). § 8652

Dear California Election Representative,

We are writing to follow up on our previous letter in regards to the 2020 Presidential Write-In Ticket of President "Ryan Ehrenreich" and Vice President "Veronica Ehrenreich" (see www.fec.gov/data/candidate/P00011395).

While some States have accepted our filing, many have not. Those who have not have cited existing State election statutes as the cause for rejection. To help bring resolution to this matter, we wish to clarify what we are asking of you.

We are NOT asking you to overturn or otherwise unilaterally invalidate your State's existing election statutes, as we know that it is not within the powers of your office to do so.

What we are asking is that you find a way to count our votes under your existing statutes. Considering the wide-ranging disruption to our society caused by the various catastrophic events of this year (including, but not limited to the COVID-19 pandemic), we view this as a very reasonable request under the circumstances.

Practically, what we hope for as the result of this request is that you and your staff:

- 1) Find other statutes that are either more important or take precedence in the order of application/enforcement, and
- 2) Apply these statutes based on the unique circumstances of the year, so that you are able to temporarily suspend or provide us with an exemption to the parts of your election statutes that we will not meet.

Should you fulfill this request, it would preserve the integrity of your statutes, but still allow our votes to be counted in the upcoming November 3rd United States Presidential Election.

Should you NOT meet this request, it is highly likely that we will need to file one or more lawsuits seeking to overturn a sizeable number of State election statutes on the grounds that these statutes are unconstitutional, as we firmly assert that this is the actual truth on this issue.

Though, we caution that the latter option may present a significant hazard to your office, as the process of said litigation would be expensive and time consuming, and the result very likely could cast into doubt a great many of your existing election statutes, forms, and procedures in such a manner as to yield vast uncertainty for future elections. This outcome would most likely necessitate subsequent action by your State legislative body to update or remove existing statutes, and this process may affect your office in undesirable ways.

So rather than file lawsuits on this matter, we hope that, based on the unique circumstances of this year and the resulting limitations therefore imposed on our candidates, you are willing and able to find legal grounds for making one-time exceptions to your State election statutes to the benefit of our candidates.

Again, we are under no obligation to provide this letter in advance in order to sue in the event our votes are not counted. Nevertheless, we have sent this information to you now as a courtesy in the hopes that this may prevent the later need for litigation on this matter.

In conclusion, we respectfully request that you find a way to use your complete set of existing statutes to provide our ticket with an exception based on the extraordinary circumstances of the current year, such that votes for our candidacy will be counted in the upcoming 2020 U.S. Presidential Election. We also request, if you have not done so already, that you **notify us of your final position on this matter via BOTH email AND United States Postal Service mail sent by Friday October 30, 2020.**

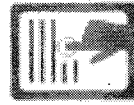

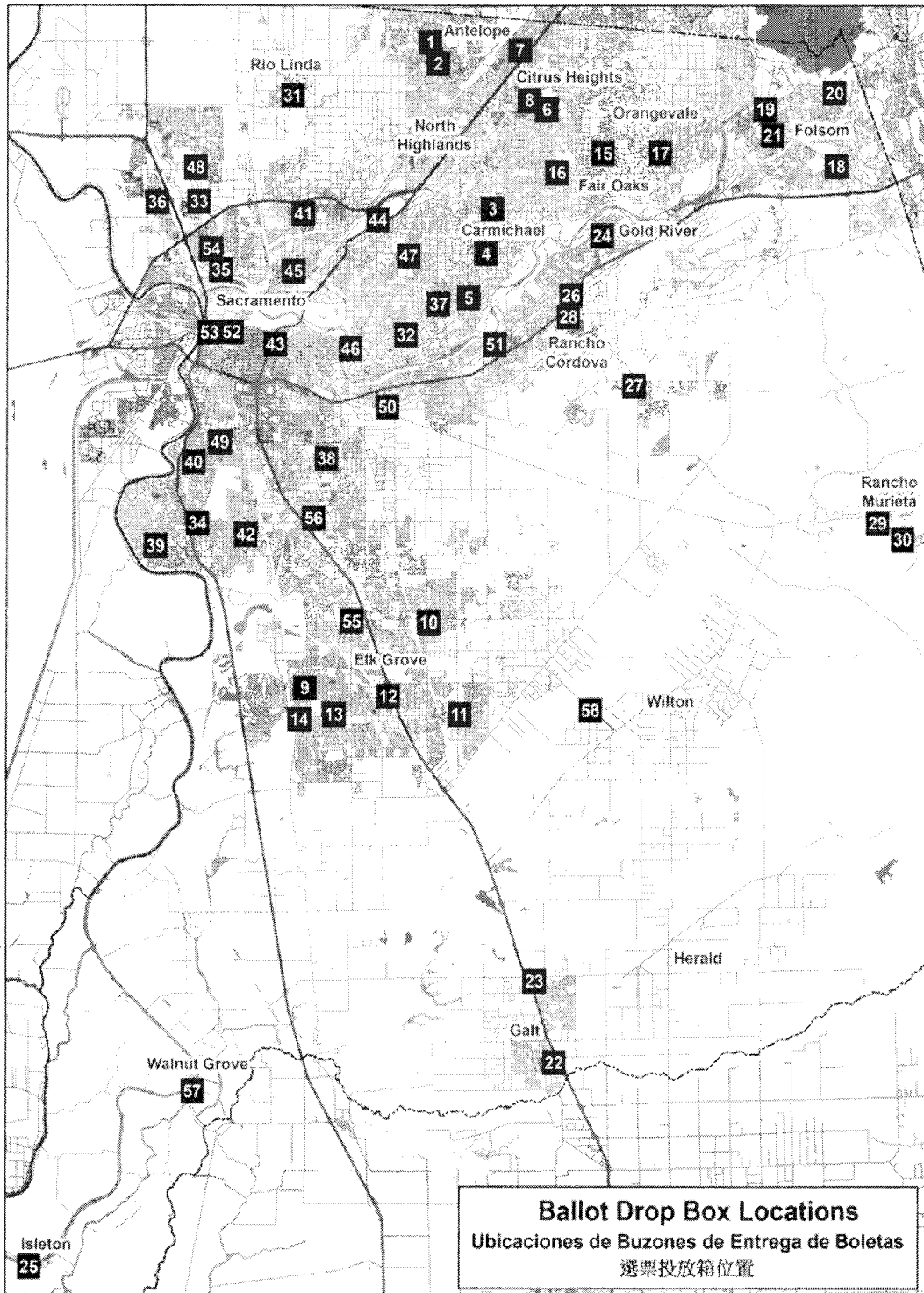

Currently, we have a "Welfare TO Work" system... And this system does not work. Poverty is a "generational challenge", not a "temporary setback".

So to really end poverty, we must guarantee FAMILIES (parent(s) with dependent children) a minimum income.

Some experimental programs aim to do this by just giving people money.

But the key is to also hold them accountable to use the money properly and to keep them work-force relevant.

So in a good system, the welfare benefits are NOT "temporary", but INSTEAD tied to "good results".

To be eligible for aid, parent(s):

- 1) Must pass random drug tests
- 2) Must show their dependent children are progressing well
- 3) Must meet a work requirement aimed at keeping them work-force relevant

The work requirement would be around 10 hours per week for single parents and 40 hours per week for 2-parent families.

To fulfill the work requirement, there would also need to be guaranteed jobs for those who cannot find one.

We advocate a plan that covers everyone flexibly, and at a much lower cost than Medicare-For-All.

Here is the plan:

- 1) We create a National Catastrophic Coverage Plan that kicks in after \$20k of healthcare spending for a given year
- 2) We price this plan at break-even cost
- 3) Each citizen gets a \$1 Million lifetime allowance for medical spending
- 4) The citizen's yearly spending (up to \$20k) and yearly Catastrophic Coverage Fee are deducted from the cap
- 5) After the Catastrophic Coverage kicks in, the additional spending is NOT deducted from the cap
- 6) The Federal Govt provides a 5% discount for paying the yearly Catastrophic Coverage Fee with money (rather than deducting it from cap)
- 7) Any additional payments by other health insurance coverage count toward the \$20k threshold, but do not reduce the cap

Also, this plan has the benefit of still encouraging recipients to seek private insurance from their respective employer.

- 1) Pricing of an individual's National Catastrophic Coverage Plan yearly fee would partially be based on the individuals usage history and partially not. The goal is to spread the cost of the VERY SICK across the wider population, so that we can effectively care for all of our people.
- 2) The National Catastrophic Coverage Plan is intended to cover any healthcare expense past the \$20k threshold, but for On-Patent, New Super-Fancy Drugs & Devices, the Plan may cover only part of the cost (or not at all). This would be made clear to the recipient and if the recipient chooses to purchase that Drug or Device, the non-covered portion of the cost would be counted against the Personal Lifetime Cap or come out-of-pocket.
- 3) This plan would cover ALL CITIZENS at a Federal Level. Once the Personal Lifetime Cap is exhausted, we would have a procedure for applying for an Extension to the Cap. These Extensions would be evaluated on a case-by-case basis using fair, transparent rationale.
- 4) Certain classes (such as Special Needs) may be exempted from the Personal Lifetime Cap, but this may come with stipulations that may impact other behaviors or life choices.
- 5) We understand that different states feel differently about covering the healthcare costs of Illegal Immigrants, and our goal is to allow states to decide individually how to handle this case.

Welfare as a Price Support for Labor

The success of AFDC was that it functioned as a Price Support for Labor (similar to how Farm Price Supports functioned in Farming).

For a program to function as a Price Support, it must PURCHASE and RETIRE the excess Supply (generally of a Commodity, such as grain or Low-Wage Labor Hours).

Price Supports are critical, as they create the conditions necessary for a stable Middle Class... Namely, they create livable Prices & Wages!

For a Welfare System to function as a Price Support, it must pay people NOT TO WORK or WORK LESS.

This is what AFDC did and what TANF does NOT do (TANF has strict Work Requirements)... This is how the Price Support for Labor was broken in USA!

So a new Welfare System should BUY and RETIRE the excess Supply of Work Hours in Low-Wage Labor.

There are some critical factors to consider, such as:

- 1) How many hours to buy per recipient?
- 2) How much to pay per hour bought?
- 3) What is the Income Cap? (the maximum income level that determines eligibility for this program)
- 4) How to provide people a ladder to a career that allows them to exit the Welfare System?

As to #1, I favor a baseline level of purchasing a maximum of 20 hours out of 40 for single parents, with the possibility of extending the maximum by 10 more hours as a Marriage Bonus (30 out of 2x40=80) or a Performance Bonus (30 out of 40).

As to #2, I favor using a Percentage of Federal Minimum Wage (e.g. 80%) to determine the pay rate. The Federal Govt would be responsible for paying this % of Federal Min Wage. The State Govt would be responsible for paying its own % of State Min Wage above Federal Min Wage. Local Govts would similarly be responsible for paying their own % Local Min Wage above State Min Wage. The State and Local Govts could choose their % values independently of the Federal Govt (setting them at anywhere from 0% to 100%).

As to #3, I favor using a percentage of Median Household Income to determine the Income Cap. The recipient household's (After Tax Income + Welfare Grants) would need to remain below the Income Cap to remain eligible.

As to #4, I favor engaging the US Dept of Labor to create the ladders out of the Welfare System. I would ask the Secretary of Labor for a list of occupations that are currently experiencing an Under-Supply of Trained Applicants (and how many are needed). Then I would allow Welfare Recipients to apply for slots in Training Programs to fill those needs. The application would gauge the applicants seriousness about completing the training program. The number of applicants accepted should be based on the number of Trained Applicants needed (plus an increase for expected attrition). The costs of Job Training should be shared between these Departments (HHS & Labor), and possibly the recipient.

Ryan 4 Prez Additionally, in normal times, I believe that eventually, due to Extreme Levels of Automation, it will be necessary to allow Childless Adults to qualify for this program.

When this needs to happen, I am for it, but I believe the Rate (i.e. Percentage of Minimum Wage paid) should be much less for Childless Adults (for example, 30% instead of 80%).

Why?

Childless Adults can live much more cheaply. They can easily combine with other Childless Adults to rent spaces as a group.

Whereas Parents must concern themselves with the best interest of their Children, so they should seek to provide a stable & safe home. Usually, this means NOT renting in a group.

Also, as Childless Adults have greater social/class mobility than Poor Parents, those Childless Adults should be given greater incentive to seek full-time employment.

Also, to make this program affordable within the Federal Budget, such considerations are important to factor into the program.

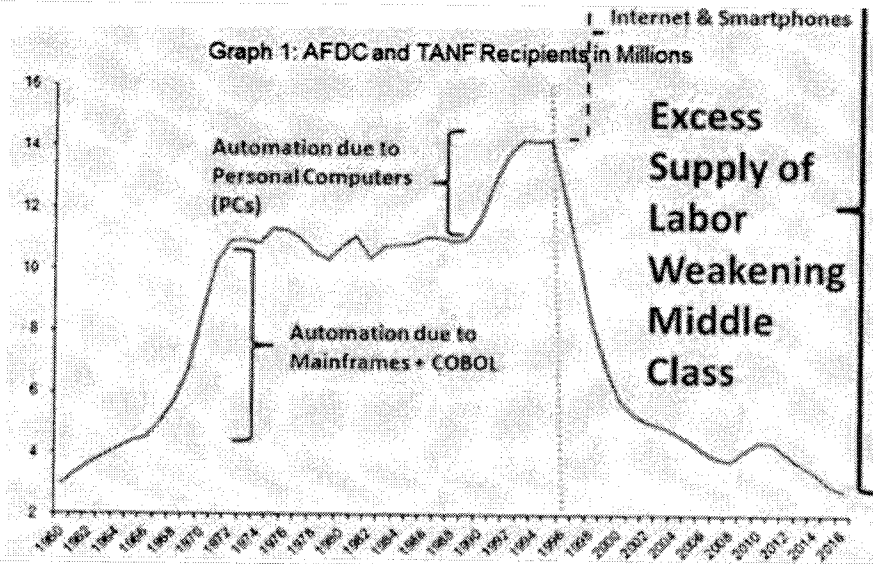

Where are we on Demand Curve of Labor?

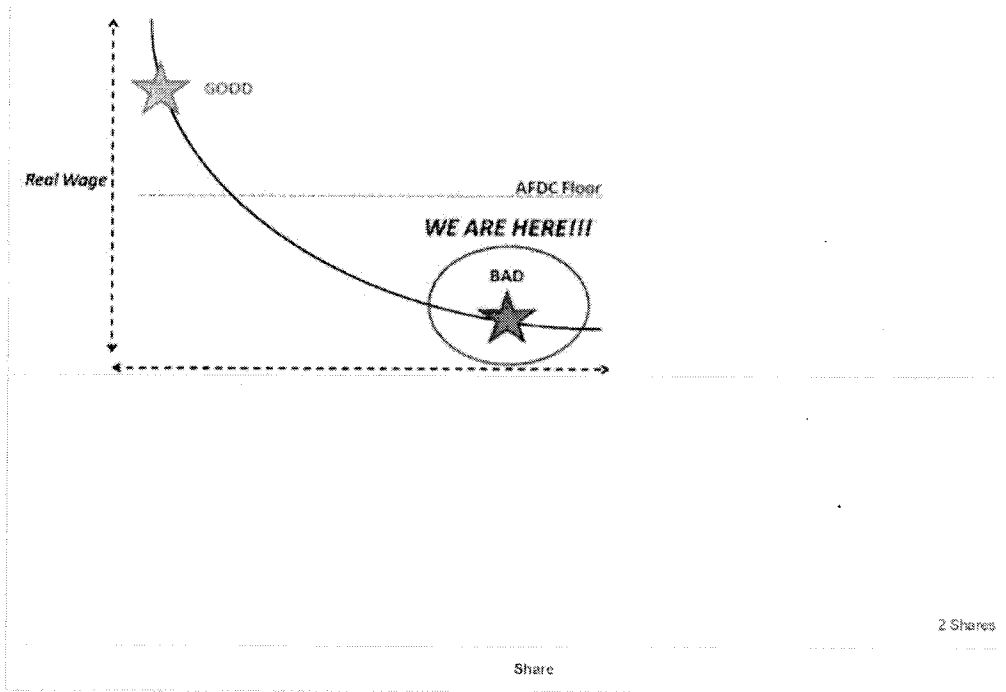

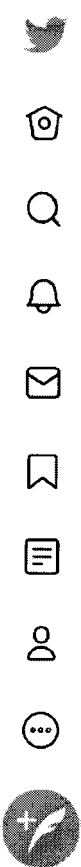

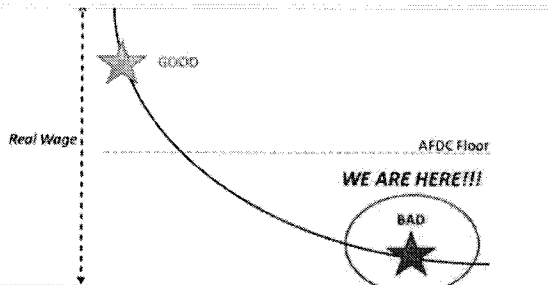

Federal Program to Pay Businesses NOT to Operate

During Pandemics, it is critical that non-essential businesses either reduce or suspend operations temporarily.

Similarly, during Disasters, some businesses may be FORCED to suspend operations due to the nature of the Disaster.

As these are NOT normal economic circumstances, it is important that the Federal Government offers a lifeline to these businesses to patch them through so as to maintain their viability to resume operations later, as well as to protect the overall economic stability of our Great Country.

As such, it is critical to create a Federal Program that pays businesses not to operate (or to reduce operations).

This program would go dominant during normal times, but could be activated by Presidential Disaster Declarations. When activated, it would automatically serve the purpose that many of the current one-off stimulus bills are designed to serve (but it would do so AUTOMATICALLY for the duration that it is needed for).

Businesses would need to register with this Program and provide financial statements that detail their operating costs during normal times.

Then the agents of this program would use this information to pay the affected businesses via grants so as to cover the necessary portion of their operating costs during the time they are expected NOT to OPERATE.

As for employees of these business, I would handle senior management separately from regular employees.

Any allowance to pay senior management would be included in the grant (though this amount may be \$0, depending on analysis from agents of the program). Senior management would be expected to remain engaged in the operations of the business for the duration of its active participation in this program.

Other employees whose work hours are temporarily reduced or eliminated would become temporarily eligible for my program that pays people not to work at a percentage of minimum wage (for example 80%) for the portion of the 40 hour work week that they DO NOT work (see <https://www.facebook.com/Ryan4Prez/posts/3008343452724868>).

Eligibility for these programs would expire when the disaster declaration is terminated. At such point, businesses would be expected to resume normal operations and normal employment of staff.
